The 1.5 ton, 18,000 B.T.U. split version of the Millennia, with its built-in smart charger, uses solar or wind power to charge on-board deep cell batteries that power its 24 or 48 volt internal system. It can also be plugged into any 110 volt outlet. Conventional air conditioning units utilize 220 volt and are significantly more costly to run.

“This is an amazing and significant step forward in the movement toward alternative energy,” stated Stan Dombrowski, President of Austin Industries. Mr. Dombrowski also stated, “The Millennia is an awesome product that will help Southern California save electricity, save money and save the environment.”
