Participate in Fresno MOBEX 2008**

June 3, 2008, *Fresno, CA* - A sustainable mobile command center was demonstrated by SolCool One, LLC and Intershelter, Inc. for a Mobilization Exercise, (MOBEX) staged over the weekend in Fresno, California. The training exercise simulated a two stage terrorist bomb and biological attack that tested the capabilities of various first responder agencies.

The Fresno Fire Department invited Intershelter to demonstrate its Force 5 sustainable command center with Millennia climate control because the hardened shell assembles as fast as a tent, withstands hurricane force winds and rain, protects against severe heat and cold and would require zero grid or generator power. "Our 320 square foot domes can also be used for communications, triage, decontamination and housing", said Captain Don Kubely, President of Intershelter. "They even pass Los Angeles City residential building codes", Captain Kubely added.

The Intershelter climate control was demonstrated by Millennia distributor, Roy LaPlant, President of Alternative Energy Solutions in Santa Maria, CA. "Four 170 watt solar panels ran the 18000 BTU Millennia all day cooling the demonstration space to 66 degrees Fahrenheit when the outside temperature was 91 degrees. The Millennia would perform as well on the heat side if it was freezing outside", commented Mr. LaPlant. "The Millennia system powers the climate control, lights DC appliances and charging for the Intershelter. Everyone is amazed at its performance and quiet operation", Mr. LaPlant went on to say.

SolCool One, LLC is currently delivering a new generation of renewable, DC HVAC with battery backup systems under the brand, "Millennia" in concert with its manufacturing partner Senergy Cooling Systems.
